

CHATEAU HAUT BERNONES

HAUT-MEDOC AOC



HISTORICAL :

Located in the village of Cussac-Fort-Medoc, next to Saint-Julien, Chateau Haut-Bernones is a beautiful 15-hectare vineyard whose origins date back more than 200 years. The main building is in neo-classical style, built in 1782, and has belonged to the Ruton family since 1948.

TERROIR :

Gravel and clay-limestone.

SURFACE :

15,5 hectares.

GRAPE VARIETIES :

47 % Cabernet Sauvignon.
53% Merlot.

CULTIVATION :

Yield : Between 40 and 50 hl / ha. Planting density : 6600 plants/ha. Mechanical tillage.
Integrated cultivation.
Sorting of grapes in the vineyard.

VINIFICATION AND AGEING :

Medocan traditional vinification in thermo-regulated stainless steel vats.
Minimum 3 weeks vatting.
Estate vacuum bottling.

SERVICING AND PAIRING :

Service temperature : 17 / 18 °C.
Decant one or two hours before tasting.
Wine is not treated, deposit is natural.
This wine will match roasted beef, duck, games and a choice of cheeses : Comté, brebis, sheddar.
