## **HISTORICAL**:

Located in the village of Cussac-Fort-Medoc, next to Saint-Julien, Chateau Haut-Bernones is a beautiful 15-hectare vineyard whose origins date back more than 200 years. The main building is in neo-classical style, built in 1782, and has belonged to the Ruton family since 1948.

### **TERROIR:**

Gravel and clay-limestone.

#### **SURFACE:**

15,5 hectares.

#### **GRAPE VARIETIES:**

47 % Cabernet Sauvignon. 53% Merlot.

#### **CULTIVATION:**

Yield: Between 40 and 50 hl / ha. Planting density: 6600 plants/ha. Mechanical tillage.
Integrated cultivation.
Sorting of grapes in the vineyard.



## **VINIFICATION AND AGEING:**

Medocan traditional vinification in thermoregulated stainless steel vats. Minimum 3 weeks vatting.

Estate vacuum bottling.

#### **SERVICING AND PAIRING:**

Service temperature: 17 / 18 °C.

Decant one or two hours before tasting.

Wine is not treated, deposit is natural.

This wine will match roasted beef, duck, games and a choice of cheeses: Comté, brebis, sheddar.
